POLICE HAVE DETAINED A SUSPECT IN CONNECTION WITH A DEADLY EXPLOSION OF A PARCEL BOMB THAT KILLED A LAW FIRM SECRETARY AND CRITICALLY INJURED A LAWYER.

AUTHORITIES SNAGGED A SUSPECT, A 45-YEAR-OLD ARCHITECT WHO HAD HARRASSED A LAWYER AT THE FIRM TWO YEARS EARLIER.

AUTHORITIES ARE STILL SEARCHING FOR THE DELIVERY WOMAN WHO DROPPED THE PACKAGE OFF AT THE FIRM. TERRORISM IS RULED OUT IN THIS CASE.

TWENTY-SIX MORE BODIES WERE FOUND IN THE AFTERMATH OF A BEIJING COAL MINE EXPLOSION, RAISING THE DEATH TOLL TO ONE-HUNDRED AND FIVE. ONLY FIFTEEN MINERS WERE ABLE TO ESCAPE THE EXPLOSION.

MINE SAFETY REGULATIONS ARE LOOSELY ENFORCED IN CHINA; BECAUSE OF THIS, CHINA'S COAL MINING INDUSTRY IS THE MOST DANGEROUS IN THE WORLD, AVERAGING THIRTEEN DEATHS A DAY DUE TO EXPLOSIONS, FIRES, AND FLOODS.

AUTHORITIES SEARCHED A
SUBURBAN DENVER HOME TO SEE IF
THERE WAS ANY LINK BETWEEN THE
TWO COLORADO CHURCH
SHOOTINGS ON SUNDAY.

AUTHORITIES BELIEVE THAT THE
SHOOTINGS WHICH OCCURRED
TWELVE HOURS APART IN TIME AND
SIXTY-FIVE MILES APART ARE
LINKED SOMEHOW.

FIVE PEOPLE WERE KILLED
INCLUDING THE GUNMAN AND FIVE
OTHERS WERE INJURED IN THE
VIOLENT SHOOTING.

THE COLD CASE OF MULTIPLE MURDERS HAS BEEN FINALLY SOLVED. IT WAS FOUND THAT A MAN WHO IS ALREADY IN PRISON WILL FACE MULTIPLE MURDER CHARGES.

THE HOMICIDES BEGAN IN 1977 AND LASTED UNTIL 1982. BETWEEN THIS TIME THE MAN WHOSE NAME IS UNDISCLOSED IS SUSPECTED OF THE RANDOM KILLING OF WOMEN IN MISSOURI.

D-N-A TESTING HAS PROVEN THAT HE IS A PRIME SUSPECT IN THE KILLING OF ALL FIVE OF THE WOMEN AGES RANGING FROM TWENTY-ONE TO SIXTY-FIVE.

OPENING HIS MOUTH,” SAID ADAM
REINGOLD, A TENANT WHO CAME TO
SEEMAN’S DEFENSE.

A DISPUTE IN QUEENS ERUPTED INTO A GUNFIGHT WHICH LEFT A WOMAN DEAD.

THE WOMAN WAS SEEN YELLING IN THE STREET SCREAMING OUT SOMETHING ABOUT THE DEATH OF HER BABY, ACCORDING TO AN EYE-WITNESS.

THE WOMAN WAS SEEN JABBING A KITCHEN KNIFE INTO A BLACK ACURA IN THE STREET WHILE ARGUING WITH THE PERSON IN THE CAR.

THE ARGUMENT RESUMED. GUNFIRE WAS HEARD AND THE WOMAN FELL TO HER KNEES WHILE CLUTCHING HER CHEST, ACCORDING TO LAWRENCE EDWARDS WHO LIVES NEAR BY.

“I DIDN’T EVEN SEE THE FLASH. IT WAS LIKE A LITTLE POP, ALMOST LIKE A TOY,” EDWARDS SAID.
